History Of The Presenting Complaint: Patient is known diabetic since 12 yrs. He was on antidiabetic Rx. Above complaints started 2 months back by prick of a fish bone (doubtful). It was a very small wound. But gradually it started increasing in size and depth. He went to local Doctor. He was given a course of antibiotic and increased dose of antidiabetic medicine. Still the wound was not healing. In addition to that there was a blackish discoloration, bleeding and offensive discharge from the part affected. Again he went back to the local doctor. He advised him to go to the hospital. He got admitted to the hospital on 12/11/03 and debridement of wound was done. He was discharged on 17/12/03 without complete healing. After going home, ulcer started increasing again then he reported to hospital again. He was given

- 1. Insulin 10 units B.D.
- 2. Atenol 50 mg 0-0-1
- 3. Amlovas 5mg. B.D.

Patient reported to our O.P.D. on 23/12/03 and patient was admitted to our. I.P.D.

Life Space Investigation:

The patient hails from higher middle class family. He got married 26 years back and has 7 sons and 2 daughters. Eldest son is 25 years old and youngest son is 6 years old. One daughter is mentally retarded. He had contractor business in Goa. It got collapsed 13 yrs. back and had more than 15 lakhs deficit. Then he left Goa and came back to his native. At first he tried for job but no hope. Ultimately he bought an auto-rickshaw and started driving that to meet his financial need. Later on his son joined him. Recently his son has got T.B. and unable to work. Somehow he was running his family. But recent problem made him very much worried as if he dies what will happen to his family. Whenever he is alone he thinks about his business failure, becomes sad and worried. He wants to be in company as company relieves his all tension. But he does not talk about his problem to others because he thinks that others will not solve his problem so it will be disturbance for them instead of telling to others. I will tell to God to release my tension.
